For each one we are opened to the abundance of your love.

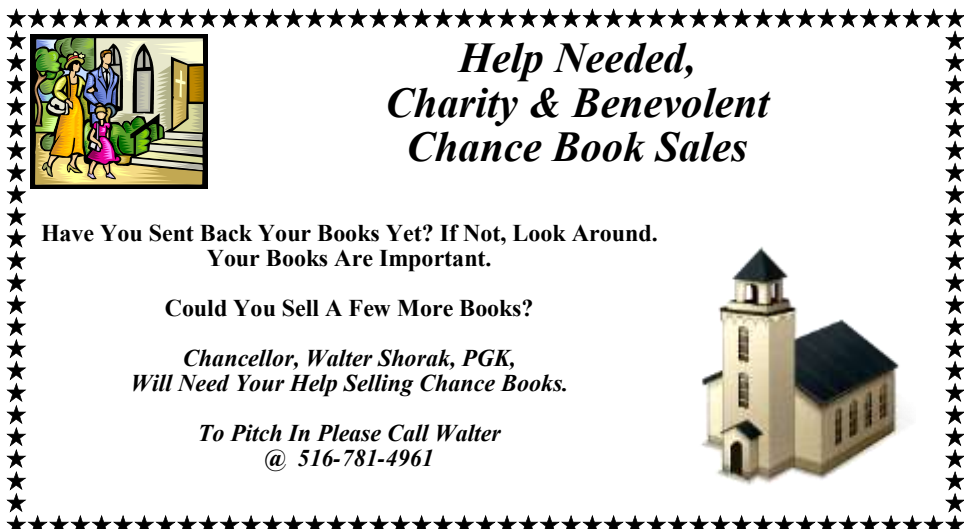

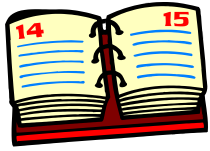
